It was MDGA's first time in 76 years that 45 holes were played. In the past, MDGA had played 18, 36, and 54 holes but not 45 holes. That's cool that we are a part of history of playing 45 holes. Last time that MDGA had to cancel the whole day was in 1974 at Brainard, Minnesota. They played only 36 holes (2 days) due to rain all day. Since 1975, we had palyed 54 holes till this year when we played only 45 holes.


